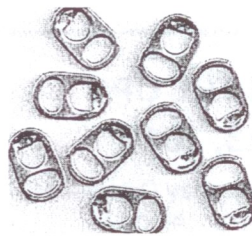
NEW BETHANY MINISTRIES' SOUPER DAY
